Since 2007 the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo in Alberta has been planning a future residential area of over 850 hectares in the community of Fort McMurray.

Dillon is working on the Saline Creek Plateau Strategic Outline Plan which provides the planning framework to identify appropriate land uses, servicing options, the development approval process and phasing to permit efficient land development.

A key component was the preparation of an Example Development Concept Plan which visually characterizes the proposed land uses and identifies how they can be implemented within the ultimate development of the Saline Creek Plateau.

This project applied the best practices in neighbourhood design and meets both our client's (RM Wood Buffalo) and the Province of Alberta's requirements for innovation and creativity. The Example Development Concept Plan establishes the required groundwork needed for a vibrant and sustainable community.
