WALKER ROAD - CPR GRADE SEPARATION CEREMONY

The Walker Road at-grade roadway in Windsor was constantly being held up by train traffic. As part of the *Let's Get Windsor-Essex Moving* strategy announced by the Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO) four years ago, Dillon, in collaboration with multiple other team members, undertook design and contract administration. This challenging project was completed a month ahead of schedule by simplifying the design, which reduced the amount of time for construction and resulted in a smaller impact on the area. Traffic efficiency will be improved and congestion reduced for tens of thousands of travellers.

During the ceremony our client, MTO, announced that the project earned an American Association of State Highway Transportation Organizations award for Value Engineering. These awards are handed out for projects that exhibit the best value add. Furthermore, this is the first time a Canadian transportation team has won one of these awards.

More than 30 Dillon people in seven offices played a significant role in the successful delivery of this project.

Next year MTO will begin a similar grade separation project on Howard Avenue, for which we completed the environmental assessment and preliminary design.
