Dillon is part of the Windsor-Essex Mobility Group, an international consortium of contractors and financiers who were chosen to deliver the most significant highway investment in Ontario's history; the \$1.6 billion, 12 kilometre Windsor-Essex Parkway.

**Eha Naylor** is leading a group of 12 landscape architects and urban designers. Over 150 Dillon staff have participated in this project. Besides landscape and urban planning, Dillon is providing professional services in highway design, bridge design, municipal services, utility relocations, drainage, traffic staging and consultation.

When the parkway is finished, trucks won't have to shudder to a complete stop at 16 traffic lights on their way through Windsor anymore, resulting in millions of litres of diesel being saved every year, meaning lower costs for truckers and less emissions going into the atmosphere.
