The KFN *Soil Law* regulates how soil and fill is brought in or taken out of Katzie First Nation.

We have received contaminated soils in the past and it's often left up to us to fix it.

If we all play a part, we can keep our environment safe and clean for us and our children.

Contaminated soil can make us sick. It also costs a lot of money to clean it up or get rid of it.

If the soil is too contaminated, it might prevent us from being able to fully use our land.

Taking contaminated soil might seem like an easy way to make money, but it costs us <u>all</u> in the long run.

A KFN Soil and Fill Transfer Permit helps us keep track of how much soil is being transferred, its condition, and where it's going.

Anyone transferring soil or fill in or out of Katzie First Nation *must* have a permit!



## How can I help protect our land?

If someone offers you money to dump soil, don't make the deal!
Let the Lands Department know as it's likely contaminated.

If you see any suspicious soil dumping activity on reserve, it's likely being done without a permit. **Report it immediately!** 

We don't want our children inheriting contaminated lands.
